1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-521** 3 WHEREAS, for fiscal year 1999 the Tohono O'odham Police Department was 4 appropriated funds to address various needs of the community and the 5 Police Department's programs; and 6 WHEREAS. due to the increase in the number of Police Officers and Rangers to the 7 Tohono O'odham Police Department, there is a need for specialized 8 equipment and trained animals in order to enhance patrol of range lands 9 of the Tohono O'odham Nation: and 10 WHEREAS, there is no line item in the current FY 1999, Tohono O'odham Police 11 Department budget for trained animals such as horses to be used for 12 search and rescue operations, crowd control, cattle rustling deterrence, 13 public relation operations, detection of illegal drugs; and 14 WHEREAS, in order to purchase such equipment and animals a new line item must be 15 established as the Trained Animal Account - 01 1090 753 and a transfer of 16 \$17,000.00 from the 01 1090 750 to 01 1090 753 is necessary. 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that 18 it hereby approves the establishment of a new line item account number 19 01 1090 753 Trained Animals to the FY 1999 Tohono O'odham Police 20 **Department Tribal Base Budget.** 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$17,000.00 from 01 1090 750 Capital Account line item 22be transferred to 01 1090 753 Trained Animals Account line item to be 23 expended accordingly. 24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>09TH.</u> day of <u>DECEMBER, 1998</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.415.0 FOR; 25 <u>512.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the</u> Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham 26 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the

Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant

to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
