

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the \$500,000 Budget of the Pisinemo District from the
Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-532

WHEREAS, at a special meeting held on December 29, 1998, the Pisinemo District did present a budget of the \$500,000 allocation from the Gaming Revenue Savings of the Tohono O'odham Nation as a funding source to supplement projects under consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did determine that the Pisinemo District has identified the need to establish an Elderly Center, a Community Watch, and a Home Work Force; and

WHEREAS, the budget summary for these three projects would be as follows:

Elderly Center	\$269,685.00
Community Watch	178,283.00
Home Work Force	<u>163,150.00</u>
	\$611,118.00; and

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District is aware that the budget total for these three projects exceeds the \$500,000 allocation, the District does have sufficient funds in its savings to supplement costs of \$111,118.00 above \$500,000 and which the District is prepared to transfer to the Tohono O'odham Nation Accounting Department \$232,113.00 for salary, fringe benefits, and insurance management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the budget to establish projects with the \$500,000 allocation to the Pisinemo District from the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming Revenue Savings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does approve the \$111,118.00 utilization of the District's savings from the FY-99 Gaming Disbursement to supplement the budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District will transfer an amount of


\$232,113.00 from its savings to the Tohono O'odham Nation Accounting Department for salary, fringe benefits and insurance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does fully support and approves the budget for the projects identified from the utilization of the \$500,000 allocation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the period for expenditure of these funds will be for Calendar Year January 01, 1999 through December 31, 1999.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




