

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Amendment of the 1995 ICDBG Award for Santa Rosa
from Infrastructure to Rehabilitation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-537

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through its then Planning and Operations Department did apply for and receive 1995 ICDBG funds for infrastructure at the Santa Rosa community; and

WHEREAS, this grant award was originally supposed to fund a portion of the IHS infrastructure for water and wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the area IHS did agree to find other funds for the proposed infrastructure at Santa Rosa and made the grant award available for amendment to rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development will not rate and rank an amendment if the request for amendment is not authorized and does not address each element of the rehabilitation criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Executive, and the Commerce and Budget & Finance Committees of the Tohono O'odham Nations Legislative Council have reviewed the amended 1995 ICDBG project proposal requested by the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa community project for rehabilitation is approved for submission to the Department of Housing and Urban Development ICDBG Grant Program for amendment of the 1995 grant award from infrastructure to rehabilitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the following project for amendment to the Department of Housing and Urban Development:


