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2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-540** 3 WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa Community has requested continued Wastewater and Water 4 System maintenance: and 5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) has the technical expertise 6 and resources required to provide and adequately maintain these systems: 7 8 and 9 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Gu Achi District and the Tohono O'odham 10 Nation that operation and maintenance be provided by TOUA. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 12 hereby grants that these systems be turned over to TOUA to provide 13 operation and maintenance, once the project is completed and 14 operational. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that TOUA is hereby granted the necessary Rights-of-Way in 16 order to allow maintenance and operation of the water and wastewater 17 systems in the Santa Rosa Community. 18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of 19 DECEMBER, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the 20 Council by Section 2 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting 21 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 22 **2**3 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 24 25 Dennis Ramon, Legislative Chairman 26 27
