2 **RESOLUTION NO. 98-541** 3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Lead Program, under the Planning and 4 **Economic Development Department has conducted lead detection testing** 5 and other activities connected with the follow up of known incidents of lead 6 detection in the Nation's children; and 7 WHEREAS, lead detection activities conducted up to this point have not allowed for 8 comprehensive lead testing of the Nation's older housing stock; and 9 WHEREAS. the current data available on the incidence of lead in the blood of the Nation's children is incomplete and inconsistently reported; and 11 WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has a grant 12 opportunity that will allow the Nation to conduct comprehensive data 13 collection for pre-1978 housing stock and comprehensive blood-lead 14 15 screening for the Nation's children; and WHEREAS, the Nation's Lead Program has only been able to be involved in responsive 16 17 screening and data collection for lead hazards on the Nation; and 18 WHEREAS, the Nation's Lead Inspector is qualified to conduct the comprehensive data 19 collection and coordinate the comprehensive blood screening for lead 20 pursuant to the grant requirements; and 21 WHEREAS, the Executive, and the Commerce and Budget and Finance Committees of the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council have reviewed the US EPA 23 grant documents and approve its submission to the Environmental 24 Protection Agency; and the Executive Branch through the Chairman and the Lead Program, as it WHEREAS. 26 exists under the Planning and Economic Development Department shall 27 implement this grant, should it be funded, under the oversight of the 28 **Planning and Economic Development Director.**
