9		for the Thomas Franco family, whose home was completely destroyed by
10		fire on December 31, 1998.
11	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
12		hereby authorizes \$112,000 to the San Xavier District from the District's
13		share of the FY99 \$500,000 supplemental set-a-side, and that this amount
14		be forwarded immediately to the district in order for it to provide
15		replacement housing for the Thomas Franco family.

17		recognizes and supports the construction of a septic tank system for the
18		Franco families on allotment #46, provided that all necessary documents
