

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appropriating \$112,000.00 to the San Xavier district from the District's share  
of the FY99 Supplemental Set-a-Side Fund of \$500,000.00 provided to each  
District, to provide Replacement Housing for the Thomas Franco Family)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-014**

1 **WHEREAS, on December 31, 1998, Thomas Franco's home was completely destroyed**  
2 **by fire; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the family does not have the financial means to replace their home; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 98-486, approved**  
5 **a supplemental set-a-side to each of the eleven districts in the amount of**  
6 **\$500,000; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District intends to use the \$112,000 of its share of the FY99**  
8 **supplemental set-a-side funding in order to provide replacement housing**  
9 **for the Thomas Franco family, whose home was completely destroyed by**  
10 **fire on December 31, 1998.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
12 **hereby authorizes \$112,000 to the San Xavier District from the District's**  
13 **share of the FY99 \$500,000 supplemental set-a-side, and that this amount**  
14 **be forwarded immediately to the district in order for it to provide**  
15 **replacement housing for the Thomas Franco family.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby also**  
17 **recognizes and supports the construction of a septic tank system for the**  
18 **Franco families on allotment #46, provided that all necessary documents**  
19 **are approved by the landowners of said allotment and filed with the**  
20 **Bureau of Indian Affairs.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day of**  
22 **JANUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0-**  
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [1] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
24 **by Section 1(d), (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
25 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
26 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
27 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


