

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Resolution for the Continuance of Authority for the Executive Branch
to Manage all Activities of the Nation's Farming Operations until the
2nd Restated Plan of Operation is Passed by Legislative Council)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-018

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Resolution No. 98-449**
2 **which authorized the Executive Branch to assume all management**
3 **functions of the Nation's farming operations until December 31, 1998; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the majority of farming management and operational functions have been**
5 **addressed and completed; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council tabled the review and**
7 **approval of the 2nd Restated Plan of Operation until the recommended**
8 **changes are incorporated into the final draft of the 2nd Restated Plan of**
9 **Operation.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation, his Executive**
11 **Branch and his appointed Executive Agriculture Committee be authorized**
12 **to continue all management functions associated with the Nation's farming**
13 **operations until the 2nd Restated Plan of Operation is approved and adopted**
14 **by Legislative Council.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 07TH day of**
16 **JANUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0-**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
18 **by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
19 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
20 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of**
21 **the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
