5	adopted the Tohono O'odham Nation Adminstrative Plan (hereinafter "the Plan")
6	as submitted by the Chairman of the Nation, wherein Section 3-1.1,
7	Communications, identified that the need to establish a radio station "because
8	through radio [the Nation] can readily disseminate public information, legislative
9	sessions, culture and entertainment"; and
10	WHEREAS, many reservations throughout the country have a radio station and have found
11	that it is the best way for direct participation in the democratic process; and
12	WHEREAS, an O'odham radio station provides an important economic development tool by
13	generating its own income, jobs and informing the public about O'odham
14	businesses.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
16	supports the Planning Grant Application for funds available through the U.S.
17	Department of Commerce, National Telecommunications and Information
18	Administration, Public Telecommunications Facilities Program.
