

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of FY 1999 Elderly Title VI Program Grant Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-021**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the**  
2                                   **elderly members of the Nation; and**

3   **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been possible in part**  
4                                   **by Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1978, as amended; and**

5   **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding by submitting a**  
6                                   **proposal to the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration**  
7                                   **on Aging for FY 1999 in the amount of \$106,350; and**

8   **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program will benefit elder members of the Tohono O'odham**  
9                                   **Nation by providing for their nutritional and social support services.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
11                                   **that it does hereby approve:**

- 12                   1. **The proposal for continued funding of the Elderly Title VI Program to**  
13                                   **provide services to eligible members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
- 14                   2. **That the term of this grant shall commence on April 01, 1999 and end**  
15                                   **on March 31, 2002.**
- 16                   3. **That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and**  
17                                   **any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**  
18                                   **the grant, and expend such funds per attached budget. Provided**  
19                                   **however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels**  
20                                   **of the grant shall be submitted for further approval by this Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 07TH day of**  
22 **JANUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0-**  
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
24 **by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
25 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
26 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of**  
27 **the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


