RESOLUTION NO. 99-032

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently funding the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Career Center with Tribal funds; and**

3 **WHEREAS, a base is in place; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a new line item has been submitted for review and approval.**

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that**
6 **it hereby approves this new line item and authorizes expenditures in**
7 **accordance with the attached new line item 01-1208-614.**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19TH day of**
9 **JANUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0 FOR; -0-**
10 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
11 **Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
12 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
13 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
14 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
