14		relating to the allotted land; and			
15	WHEREAS,	the Housing Committee recommends that the Legislative Council approve			
16		the lease.

19		form attached hereto.			
20		2. The Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Chairman of the			
21		Nation to execute the lease and submit them to the Bureau of Indian
