

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving One (1) Land Lease for Construction of HUD Housing)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-042**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association (TOKA) was established by the**  
2                   **Legislative Council pursuant to Ordinance No. 98-03 to construct federally**  
3                   **funded housing projects for members of the Nation conjunction with the**  
4                   **United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD);**  
5                   **and**

6   **WHEREAS, TOKA has received funding to construct and operate a Mutual Help**  
7                   **Housing Project known as Project AZ 26-32 (the "Project"); and**

8   **WHEREAS, construction of the housing unit requires that TOKA secure a lease of**  
9                   **Allotted Land for the Project homesite; and**

10   **WHEREAS, attached hereto is one (1) lease between TOKA and the Tohono O'odham**  
11                   **Nation under which the Nation would lease Allotted Land for the Project**  
12                   **homesite (the "Lease"); and**

13   **WHEREAS, the District in which the homesite is situated has approved the Lease**  
14                   **relating to the allotted land; and**

15   **WHEREAS, the Housing Committee recommends that the Legislative Council approve**  
16                   **the lease.**

17   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 18                   **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the lease in the**  
19                   **form attached hereto.**
- 20                   **2. The Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Chairman of the**  
21                   **Nation to execute the lease and submit them to the Bureau of Indian**  
22                   **Affairs for approval.**

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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day  
2 of FEBRUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0  
3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
4 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
5 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
6 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
7 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


