

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Enter into Reciprocal Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Career Center
and Pima Community College to offer PCC Credit for Career Center Courses)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-045

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation is empowered to**
2 **secure and promote the health, welfare, and education of the membership**
3 **of the Nation and considers education and career training as among its**
4 **highest priorities; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Career Center endeavors to offer to its students the**
6 **highest standard of employment training and is willing to adopt the**
7 **curricula, standards, instructor certification and for credit requirements**
8 **of Arizona Community Colleges in the skill-training areas; and**

9 **WHEREAS, Pima Community College is willing to sponsor and certify Tohono**
10 **O'odham Career Center Courses and instructors, and on reciprocal basis,**
11 **award credit to students with no cost to the students, the Career Center or**
12 **the Nation.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
14 **herein endorses and authorizes the reciprocal agreement between Pima**
15 **Community College and the Nation regarding the accreditation of the**
16 **Career Center courses and instructors, and authorizes the Chairman of the**
17 **Tohono O'odham Nation to sign the agreement.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day**
19 **of FEBRUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0**
20 **FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**
21 **vested in the Council by Section 1 & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**
23 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on**
24 **March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
