RESOLUTION NO. 99-053

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights**
2 **Office since 1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham ; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights**
5 **Office has been supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity**
6 **Commission; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is**
8 **essential to eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior**
9 **boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and**
11 **the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been**
12 **approved by the Office of the Chairman.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative**
14 **Council that it hereby approves the continued supplemental funding for**
15 **the Tribal Employment Rights Office from the Equal Employment**
16 **Opportunity Commission.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October**
18 **01, 1998 through September 30, 1999.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that**
20 **the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman and any**
21 **designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
22 **grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding, or**

1 funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval
2 by this Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 09TH day
4 of FEBRUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0
5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
6 vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
7 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
8 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
9 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


