8	WHEREAS,	on the date of February 13, 1998 contracts were signed for the purchase of
9		one (1) Pierce Quantum Custom Pumper/Tanker and three (3) Pierce
10		Saber Custom Pumper; and
11	WHEREAS,	each truck was to be custom made and would take eight (8) months to
12		deliver; and
13	WHEREAS,	remaining monies were to be utilized to purchase all capital equipment
14		needed; and
15	WHEREAS,	the capital equipment purchase was delayed pending delivery of the
16		custom made trucks to assure proper equipment was ordered; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Fire Department request to reappropriate remaining monies in the
18		amount of \$176,487.00 to purchase fire capital equipment that will be
19		essential to the operation of these new fire trucks.
20	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
21		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes carry
22		over funding from Fiscal Year 1998 to Fiscal Year 1999 and authorizes
23		Capital purchases in the amount of \$176,487.00 for the acquisition of
24		the fire equipment.
