

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement Automatic Response with the
Tohono O'odham Nation, Pascua Yaqui Tribe, Drexel Heights Fire Department,
and Tucson Estates Fire District)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-069

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department provides Fire and**
2 **Emergency Services throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has limited resources and**
4 **manpower to adequately respond to calls throughout the Nation because**
5 **of the distance between the Fire Department's headquarters and the**
6 **outlying districts; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department will be opening substations**
8 **throughout the Nation to improve its response capability; and**

9 **WHEREAS, districts have expressed the need to have Fire and Emergency services**
10 **capable of responding to emergencies in a timely manner throughout the**
11 **Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, representatives of the Tohono O'odham Nation have negotiated a Mutual**
13 **Automatic Response Agreement with Drexel Heights Fire District, Tucson**
14 **Estates Fire Department, and Pascua Yaqui Tribe to further improve Fire**
15 **and Emergency response time throughout the Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General did approve the Mutual Aid Agreement; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed**
18 **the agreement and recommends approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 20 1. **The Mutual Aid Agreement is approved in the form attached hereto.**
- 21 2. **The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to sign the Agreement on**
22 **behalf of the Nation. The Chairman of the Nation is also authorized**

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1 to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement Automatic Response with
2 other Fire Departments and emergency services that will benefit the
3 Nation in emergency response.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10TH day
5 of FEBRUARY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,359.0 FOR;
6 379.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested
7 in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
8 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the
9 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
10 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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


