

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Supporting San Xavier District's Use of the Remaining Balance of the \$500,000**  
**FY 99 Supplemental Funds from the Tohono O'odham Nation Gaming**  
**Revenue Savings, Pursuant to Resolution No. 98-486)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-074**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council (Council), pursuant to Resolution No. 98-  
2 486, authorized supplemental funds to each of the eleven Districts of the  
3 Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) in the amount of \$500,000; and

4 WHEREAS, it was understood at that time that in order for each District to obtain the  
5 funds, the Districts needed to provide through the Nation's regular  
6 funding process, a budget, justification and resolution for approval by the  
7 Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District is in dire need of housing for its constituents, some  
9 who have been on the District's emergency housing list for a number of  
10 years; and

11 WHEREAS, the District, and the Tohono O'odham Council previously authorized an  
12 expenditure of \$112,000 from the supplemental funds, to provide  
13 replacement housing for the Thomas Franco family whose home was  
14 destroyed by fire.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
16 Council hereby authorizes and agrees to release the remaining funds of  
17 \$388,000 from the supplemental gaming revenue savings, to the San Xavier  
18 District, which will then be used to provide permanent homes to needy  
19 members.

20 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the period for expenditure of these funds is January 01,  
21 1999 through December 31, 1999.

7 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
