1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did previously adopt calendar
2 year budgets containing projections for administration of the P.L. 93-638
3 Grant Agreements 6-FG-32-00100; and

4 WHEREAS, a funding agreement for calendar year 1999 has been executed by the
5 Nation and the Bureau of Reclamation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has presented this modification to the
7 appropriate committees and the committees wish to bring it before the
8 Legislative Council.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10 that it hereby approves Budget Modification No. 06 to the Grant
11 Agreement and authorizes expenditures as identified in the modification
12 attached hereto.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 02ND.
14 day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,728.0
15 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 199.0 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
16 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
17 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
18 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
19 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


