6 WHEREAS, the Transportation Program budget has been reviewed by the Tohono
7 O'odham Legislative Council Commerce and Budget and Finance
8 Committees; and

9 WHEREAS, the said budget is hereby presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative
10 Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
12 hereby approves the Transportation Program budget for the amount of
13 \$186,645.00.

15 day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0
16 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
17 vested in the Council by Section 1 d(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
18 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986;
19 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
20 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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
