

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of the Budget Modification #3 for the 1994 ICDBG)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-097**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received a grant to conduct housing**  
2                   **rehabilitation, issued through the United States Department of Housing**  
3                   **and Urban Development; and**

4   **WHEREAS, this grant requires a budget modification #3 to the Administrative Budget**  
5                   **to make the appropriate and necessary adjustments to create a new line**  
6                   **item for Utilities to maintain appropriate administration of this grant up**  
7                   **to close-out; and**

8   **WHEREAS, these budget modifications have been reviewed and approved by the**  
9                   **following entities and committees of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
10                  **Council: Grants and Contracts in Accounting, the Executive Committee,**  
11                  **the Commerce Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee; and**

12   **WHEREAS, these budget modifications are as follows:**

- 13                   **1. Reduction of the Contingency Line Item; and**  
14                   **2. Creation of the Utilities Line Item; and**  
15                   **3. Addition of the \$1,300 dollars moved from the Contingency Line Item**  
16                   **to the Utilities Line Item.**

17   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
18                   **hereby approves of the proposed budget modifications to the 1994 ICDBG**  
19                   **Administrative Budget in order to maintain appropriate administration**  
20                   **of this grant and getting the benefit to the people of the Tohono O'odham**  
21                   **Nation.**

2 day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0  
3 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
4 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
5 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
6 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
7 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
