

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1997 Water Resources Study Program Budget Modification No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-099

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water Resources
2 Study Program under a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of
3 Reclamation; and

4 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono
5 O'odham Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted a proposed contract
7 application complete with a budget totaling \$1,757,871.00 to the Bureau
8 of Reclamation for the continuation of the Water Resources Study
9 Program during April 1, 1997 thru September 30, 1997; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States has a statutory obligation pursuant to Section 303 (b) (1)
11 of the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act to provide funds for
12 the Water Resources Study Program; and

13 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program does submit for review and approval
14 of Budget Modification No. 1 reflecting the amount of \$137,293.00; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 1997 Water
16 Resources Study Program contract proposal and budget.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
18 that:

19 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request
20 the Bureau of Reclamation to renew with the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended the provision of service titled:

23 2. An amount of \$137,293.00 has been identified by Bureau of

11 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
