

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1998 Water Resources Study Program Budget Justification)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-100

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water Resources**
2 **Study Program under a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of**
3 **Reclamation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono**
5 **O'odham Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted a proposed contract**
7 **application complete with a budget totaling \$216,264.00 to the Bureau of**
8 **Reclamation for the continuation of the Water Resources Study Program**
9 **during fiscal year 1998; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the United States has a statutory obligation pursuant to Section 303 (b) (1)**
11 **of the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act to provide funds for**
12 **the Water Resources Study Program; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program does submit for review and approval**
14 **of Budget Justification reflecting the amount of \$216,264.00; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 1998 Water**
16 **Resources Study Program contract proposal and budget.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
18 **that:**

19 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request**
20 **the Bureau of Reclamation to renew with the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended the provision of service titled:**
22 **Water Resources Study Program.**

23 **2. An amount of \$216,264.00 has been identified by Bureau of**

1 Reclamation as actual expenditures from October 1, 1997 thru
2 September 30, 1998.

3 3. The duration of this contract will commence on October 1, 1997
4 through September 30, 1998.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
6 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman
7 and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and
8 execute the Contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting
9 the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
10 further prior approval by this Council.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 02ND.
12 day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,479.0
13 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 448.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
14 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
15 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
16 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
17 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
