

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1998 Water Resources Study Program Budget Justification)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-102

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water Resources
2 Study Program under a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian
3 Affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono
5 O'odham Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, an amount of \$50,000.00 is allocated for the United States Geological
7 Service Cooperative Border Study; and

8 WHEREAS, authorization was requested and granted to enter into a joint funding
9 agreement between the U.S. Geological Survey and the Water Resources
10 Study Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation to conduct a hydrological
11 investigation along the portion of the southern boundary of the Nation
12 and \$50,000.00 is to fund this cooperative agreement; and

13 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program does submit for review and approval
14 of the Budget Justification reflecting the amount of \$50,000.00; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 1999 Water
16 Resources Study Program budget.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
18 that:

- 19 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request
20 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended the provision of service titled:
22 Water Resources Study Program.

2. The duration of this contract will commence on October 1, 1997 through September 30, 1998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 02ND day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,398.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 80.5 NOT VOTING; and 448.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


