12		Revenue allocation plan; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Enrollment Office did prepare and present a budget request, attached
14		and incorporated into this resolution; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Executive Office of the Chairman recommends approval of this
16		budget request; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee and Budget & Finance Committee reviewed and
18		approved the attached budget; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council did by resolution #97-478, Establishing Set-aside
20		Accounts at Bank of America for Initiative Measures, allocate \$1,800,000.00
21		to provide for the administrative cost of implementing the provisions of
22		Initiative IN-01-97.
