

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 Appropriations Priority Listing)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-117

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually
2 for consideration by Congress during its Appropriations Hearings; and

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee recommends the establishment
4 of top priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the
5 people; and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has established four areas as
7 the top priorities for FY 2000 for consideration by Congress during the
8 appropriations process.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
10 that it hereby adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY
11 2000 and respectfully urges Congress to appropriate such funds as
12 necessary to increase the four areas to an exemplary level of funding:

21 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
