### RESOLUTION NO. 99-119

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land area of 2.8 million acres and a
2		population of 23,000 members contracts its own Law Enforcement
3		program; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation operates a Corrections facility as part of its
5		Law Enforcement Program; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Corrections building is owned by the BIA and was constructed to
7		house thirty six inmates; and
8	WHEREAS,	the current Jail facility is considered very over crowded because it
9		regularly houses over one hundred ten inmates; and
10	WHEREAS,	the current Jail has no space to develop educational or treatment programs
11		for the inmates; and
12	WHEREAS,	the people of the Tohono O'odham Nation seek to provide a safe, secure
13		and humane environment for those awaiting trial and those who are
14		serving a jail sentence; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the
16		Tohono O'odham Police Department in its request to increase the P.L. 93-
17		638 funded positions in the Jail from the inadequate number of seven to
18		a more realistic number of forty.
19	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20		hereby requests increased funding under P.L. 93-638 in the amount of
21		\$18.5 million dollars for the construction of a new Adult Corrections
22		facility.
