

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department's FY 2000
Request for Budget Appropriations)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-121

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation covers an area in excess of 2.8 million acres
2 and has a population of 23,000 people who are widely dispersed
3 throughout the four, separated reservation lands; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is largely dependent on quality training and
5 education of its membership, which is also dependent on appropriate
6 funding; and

7 WHEREAS, economic development on the Nation hinges on the ability of the
8 educational system to provide a pool of people with the expertise that will
9 enable them to be contributors to their Nation's governance and economic
10 future; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department has submitted an
12 appropriation request to expand services provided under the existing
13 programs of Employment Assistance, Johnson O'Malley and the Tohono
14 O'odham Career Center in the amount of \$1,291,970.20.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
16 that it recognizes and supports the request for budget appropriations in
17 the amount of \$1,291,970.20.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee are hereby authorized
19 and directed to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members
20 and committees of Congress.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day
22 of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0
23 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
24 vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
