

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Re-Affirming Vamori Bridge/Roads)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-123

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has requested district input for
2 FY 2000 priorities for the Nation; and,

3 WHEREAS, Vamori Bridge Project and Roads are still a priority for Chukut Kuk
4 District; and,

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council reaffirms that the Vamori
6 Bridge and Vamori Community roads remain a priority until completed
7 for the following reasons:

- 8 1. School bus cannot cross the wash when it is running and children are
9 missing school.
- 10 2. Some of the children are crossing the wash to meet the school bus on
11 the other side and going to school in wet clothes.
- 12 3. Families are at risk while trying to cross the wash wanting to get
13 home.
- 14 4. There are only two operators (BIA employees) to clear the wash when
15 the wash is running. They also have to provide coverage for the
16 Tohono O'odham Nation.
- 17 5. Unforeseen medical emergencies have required and will require the
18 services of a helicopter.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
25 hereby reaffirms that the Vamori Bridge and Community Roads remain
26 a priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation until the Vamori bridge is
27 completed.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee are hereby authorized

1 and directed to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members
2 and committees of Congress.


3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day
4 of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0
5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
6 vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
7 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
8 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
9 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
