

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 Appropriations Requests for Tohono O'odham Department
of Health and Human Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-130

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") suffers from a number of**
2 **illnesses and diseases including, but not limited to the highest rate of**
3 **diabetes mellitus, alcoholism, malignant neoplasms and accidents with**
4 **adverse effects; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Department of Health and**
6 **Human Services offers programs concerned with the delivery of services**
7 **which addresses the illnesses and diseases afflicting the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation this year is identifying four specific Health**
9 **issues which are:**

- 10 • **Opposition to the President's Budget Reduction of the Community**
11 **Health Representative Program of five million dollars (\$5,000,000).**
- 12 • **Request support for construction of the Westside (Kerwo) Health**
13 **Center for thirteen million seven hundred thousand dollars**
14 **(\$13,700,000).**
- 15 • **Support funding of fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) for Joint**
16 **Venture Demonstration Program authorized in Section 818 of the**
17 **Indian Health Care Improvement Act, Public Law 94-437.**
- 18 • **Request for additional funding for Sells Service Unit Pharmacy Drug**
19 **Budget for Diabetes treatment for one hundred forty five thousand**
20 **dollars (\$145,000).**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
22 **that:**

- 23 1. **The Nation opposes the five million dollars (\$5,000,000) reduction of**

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the Community Health Representatives Program in the FY 2000 President's Budget.

2. Request support for construction of the Westside (Kerwo) Health Center.
3. Request funding of fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) for Joint-Venture Demonstration Program authorized in Section 818 of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, Public Law 94-437.
4. Request for additional funding for Sells Service Unit Pharmacy Drug Budget for Diabetes treatment of one hundred forty five thousand dollars (\$145,000).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members and committees of Congress.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0 FOR; -0 AGAINST; -0 NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


