

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 2000 Federal Appropriations Request for the Native American  
Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act, NAHASDA)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-131**

- 1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has a land base of approximately 3 million**  
2                   **acres with a population of 23,000 members; and**
- 3   **WHEREAS, number of housing units that are currently being managed through the**  
4                   **newly established TDHE, Tohono O'odham Ki:ki Association (TOKA),**  
5                   **totals 1,082; and**
- 6   **WHEREAS, the Ki:ki Association have identified the need for new home construction**  
7                   **and rehabilitation due to the substandard conditions on housing here on**  
8                   **the Nation that far exceeds the current available funding of \$6.3 million**  
9                   **dollars under NAHASDA; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, the Act provides for Indian Tribes the right to exercise Indian Self-**  
11                   **Determination and Self Governance, it fails to provide adequate federal**  
12                   **funding; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the President is currently proposing a budget of \$620 million dollars**  
14                   **which is \$136 million dollars less than FY 1999 budget of \$756 million**  
15                   **dollars.**
- 16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby**  
17                   **requests Congress to appropriate a total of \$972 million dollars to enable**  
18                   **NAHASDA to be adequately implemented.**
- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation herein request that the**  
20                   **ACT is supplemented with the appropriate and necessary tools such as**  
21                   **Indirect Costs, Program Income and Disaster Aid.**
- 22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that HUD make available the NAHASDA funding**

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utilizing the lump sum method to enable the TDHE (Tohono O'odham Ki:ki Association) to implement its' other activities.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate agencies, members and committees of Congress.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,737.0 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 190.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




