

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 1999 Division of Community Health Representatives/  
O'odham in Mexico (OIM) Budget Modification #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-133**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently providing transportation  
2 services for enrolled members that reside in Mexico for health care and  
3 services; and

4 WHEREAS, there is a need for a satellite phone for urgent patient needs, such as  
5 emergencies, location of clients in the rural remote area and to cover the  
6 cost of food and lodging for clients; and

7 WHEREAS, the Division of Community Health Representatives has modified the  
8 OIM Transportation Services budget to add line items to cover cost of  
9 purchasing a satellite phone and the cost of lodging and food for clients;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, a budget modification has been submitted for review and approval by the  
12 Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health  
13 Representatives.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 15 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the  
16 attached budget modification #1.
- 17 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and  
18 Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to  
19 negotiate and execute the contract.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day  
21 of MARCH, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,595.0  
22 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 332.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
23 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
24 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986;  
25 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)  
26 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


