

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Youth Services FY 99-00 United Way Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-145

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'odham
2 Youth Services (T.O.Y.S.) Program under an agreement with United Way
3 of Tucson; and

4 WHEREAS, the main purpose and goals of the T.O.Y.S. Program is to promote and
5 encourage young Tohono O'odham people in the fields of recreation,
6 education, cultural experiences and youth development; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services Program has submitted a proposal
8 for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

9 WHEREAS, the budget proposal is in accordance with resolution 97-139 authorizing
10 the Tohono O'odham Youth Services to enter into an agreement with
11 United Way of Tucson.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
13 supports and approves the FY 1999-2000 Tohono O'odham Youth Services
14 United Way Budget.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH day
16 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;
17 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
18 the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
19 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
20 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
21 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
