

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Human Services/
Special Projects-Nursing Project-FY99 Tribal Budget Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-146


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services is presently
2 operating the Nursing Home Project Office through approved Tribal
3 funding; and

4 WHEREAS, a budget modification has been submitted which does not change the
5 funding level but includes reclassification of Office Support Worker
6 position to Administrative Assistant positions from approved date January
7 15, 1999 and modifies other line items.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
9 hereby approves the attached FY99 Nursing Home Project Office Tribal
10 Budget Modification #1 as reflected in the attached budget.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH day
12 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;
13 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
14 the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
15 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
16 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
17 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


