9		Attorney for the remainder of FY-99 and projects the cost of such services
10		at \$20,000.00; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Advocate Program has presented a contract for David M. Juarez which
12		confirms and ratifies the terms and conditions related to future services,
13		a copy of which is attached; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative
15		Council of an Attorney Contract with David M. Juarez on such terms for
16		the remainder of FY-99.

19		Contract for David M. Juarez in the form attached hereto, for the
