

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 1999 Department of Human Services/Division of
Community Health Services - Elder Health Care Initiative Budget
Modification #3)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-150

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently developing a Home Health
2 Agency under IHS Grant #ISH002103-02 with the Indian Health Services;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 97-265, approved a five
5 year project and year two budget in the amount of \$189,050.00; and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 98-500, approved the use
7 of Project Year 1 (FY 98) carryover funds in Project Year 2 (FY 99); and

8 WHEREAS, there is a continued need for coordinated, comprehensive delivery of
9 basic Home Health Care to frail and disabled elders in their home on the
10 Tohono O'odham Nation; and

11 WHEREAS, a budget modification is submitted for review to continue the
12 development of a Home Health Agency.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL:

- 14 1. Hereby approves the reallocation of approved funds to other line
15 items in the Elder Initiative Budget.
- 16 2. Hereby authorizes the use of additional Project Year 1 (FY 98)
17 carryover funds identified for Project Year 2 (FY 99) expenditures.
- 18 3. Hereby approves the Elder Health Care Initiative, Budget
19 Modification #3 as submitted.
- 20 4. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and
21 Vice Chairman and any designated Official is hereby authorized to
22 negotiate and execute contracts associated with this grant and to
