

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Wellness Budget Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-152

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has approved a Wellness Budget for Youth
2 and Elders for activities; and

3 WHEREAS, due to a majority of the Elders being infirm and frail, they are unable to
4 attend conferences which are at a distance due to their immobility; and

5 WHEREAS, in addition, many do not fully understand the English language as
6 O'odham is their primary language; and

7 WHEREAS, a budget modification has been submitted which does not change the
8 funding level but adds new line items and increase and decrease current
9 line items to fund an Elder Conference including a Staff Retreat.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wellness Budget for fiscal year 1999
11 is hereby approved as presented and is authorized to be expended
12 accordingly.

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14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
15 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;
16 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
17 the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
18 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
19 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
20 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
