

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 Weatherization Assistance Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-155

1 **WHEREAS, request for proposal application have been made available for tribal**
2 **grants for FY 2000 through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona,**
3 **Weatherization Assistance Program; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance is available to the Tohono O'odham Nation**
5 **to assist O'odham members who meet the eligibility requirements; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to request for FY**
7 **2000 Weatherization Assistance Program funds; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted for**
9 **review and approval of a scope of work and budget that will conform to**
10 **the eligibility criteria set for in the funding and reporting regulations.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 12 1. **The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorize the**
13 **officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to submit a request for**
14 **Weatherization Assistance Funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of**
15 **Arizona and authorizes expenditures in accordance to the attached**
16 **budget.**
- 17 2. **The duration of the grant shall be from July 01, 1999 through June 30,**
18 **2000.**
- 19 3. **The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and**
20 **Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to**
21 **negotiate and execute the grant.**


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1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
2 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;
3 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
4 the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
5 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
6 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
7 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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
