

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Fiscal Year 1999 Supplemental Appropriation for the Tohono O'odham
Law Enforcement)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-178

1 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and presented a fiscal year 1999
2 supplement budget request for the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement
3 Department (Department) in the amount of \$307,010.27; and

4 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch requests that the supplemental funding listed as
5 recurring operational expense be made a part of the operating base for the
6 Department; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has historically
8 supported the complete funding requirements of the Department and has
9 made it a priority use for the Nation's Gaming Revenues.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
11 that the Executive Branch's Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement
12 Supplement Budget for fiscal year 1999, in the amount of \$307,010.27, is
13 hereby adopted as presented, and is authorized to be expended
14 accordingly.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day
17 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,332.0 FOR;
18 -0- AGAINST; 120.0 NOT VOTING; and 475.0 [14] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
19 vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
20 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986;
21 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
22 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


