

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
(FY 1999 Surplus Funding - Law Enforcement Tohono O'odham Police Department)

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-179**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and a  
2 population of 23,000 members contracts its own Law Enforcement,  
3 Corrections, and Ranger programs; and

4 WHEREAS, current facilities are in need of improvement; and

5 WHEREAS, current fleet is in need of replacement; and

6 WHEREAS, the Department is in need of developing a tactical operations unit; and

7 WHEREAS, the Department's 911 system is in need of Y2K upgrades; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has identified a surplus of Law  
9 Enforcement dollars totaling \$568,414.64 from FY 98 savings.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
11 that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of surplus Law Enforcement  
12 dollars in the amount of \$568,414.64 for Law Enforcement programs.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day  
14 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,332.0 FOR;  
15 120.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 475.0 [14] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
16 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
17 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
18 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
19 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


