12		to serve for 30 days from the enactment of this resolution; and			
13	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 98-374 was enacted on September 21, 1998 and the			
14		allowable 30 days has expired on October 21, 1998.			
15	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council			
16		hereby establishes the former interim Advisory Board.			
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each current elected District Chairperson of the				
18		eleven districts are hereby appointed to serve as an interim Advisory			
19		Board to the OCO to continue to discharge the duties of the office, until			
20		the May 1999 General Session of the Legislative Council.
