

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Tohono O'odham Head Start Program Fiscal Year 1999 Budget**  
**Modification #1 November 01, 1998 - October 31, 1999)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-189**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Head Start Program to  
2 provide educational, health/mental health, and parent involvement  
3 services for children three to five years of age; and

4 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for  
5 Children and Families provides funds for the continued operation of the  
6 Head Start Program; and

7 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a budget modification which  
8 reflects using savings from vacant positions to move into much needed  
9 operational costs, thus ensuring provision of services, health, safety and  
10 appropriate learning experiences for the children being served.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
12 that the Tohono O'odham Head Start Fiscal Year 1999 Budget  
13 Modification #1 in the amount of \$1,196,607.00, is hereby adopted as  
14 presented and is authorized to be expended accordingly.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the  
16 Tohono O'odham Nation's Official to wit: The Chairman, and any  
17 designated officials are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the  
18 contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding  
19 levels of the contract shall be submitted for prior approval by this  
20 Council.

3 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
4 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
5 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
6 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
7 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
