1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports its members, especially the Elders;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, an Elder's Day, S - Ge'egkogkam Ha - Tasga, will occur on May 15, 1999
4 at Topawa Intermediate School; and

5 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services has requested a donation to pay for
6 \$1,000.00 conference bags at a total amount of \$9,440.00.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council has reviewed
8 the request and approves a donation in the amount of \$2,440.00 from the
9 Legislative Branch Budget and further authorizes the balance of \$7,000
10 from the General Revenues Account for a total donation of \$9,440.00 for
11 purchase of conference bags.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19TH day
14 of APRIL, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,785.0 FOR;
15 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
16 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
17 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
18 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
19 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
