

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acknowledging receipt of Sensory Management Services, LLC's
proposal entitled "PREVENTION OF COMPLICATIONS OF DIABETIC
NEUROPATHY" and in support of the concepts contained therein)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-211

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation identifies health as one of its top priorities;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, members of the Tohono O'odham Nation suffer from a high rate of
4 diabetes and are at risk for contracting diabetes and its complications
5 such as foot ulceration, neuropathy, limb amputation, kidney failure etc.;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, Dr. A. Lee Dellon, M.D., Professor of Plastic Surgery and Neurosurgery
8 at Johns Hopkins University, has been interested in peripheral nerve
9 problems; and

10 WHEREAS, in 1997 Dr. Dellon began his company, Sensory Management Services,
11 LLC, a Maryland Corporation to provide his patented computer-assisted
12 sensory and motor equipment testing; and

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Dellon has a strong interest in assisting the Tohono O'odham Nation
14 in the testing and prevention of Diabetic neuropathy by use of computer-
15 assisted sensory testing; and

16 WHEREAS, Sensory Management Services, LLC has submitted a proposal entitled
17 "Prevention of Complications of Diabetic Neuropathy" to the Health and
18 Human Services Committee which is attached as exhibit "A" and
19 incorporated herein by this reference; and

20 WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has received and reviewed the
21 proposal and recommends that the Legislative Council support the
22 concepts outlined in the proposal.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

2 hereby:

- 3 1. Acknowledges receipt of the attached proposal;
- 4 2. Supports the concepts outlined in the proposal; and
- 5 3. Authorizes Dr. A. Lee Dellon, M.D. and Sensory Management
- 6 Services, LLC, to coordinate and work with Nation Officials such as
- 7 the Health and Human Services Committee and Human Services
- 8 Department and IHS to develop a program implementation plan
- 9 which will be subject to future review and approval of the Legislative
- 10 Council in approximately two months.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day

12 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;

13 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in

14 the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham

15 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by

16 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,

17 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


