

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Amending Resolution No. 99-213, "Approval of the Establishment of a Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office to assist all Veterans on the Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation")**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-214**

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 99-213, "Approval of the  
2 Establishment of a Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office to  
3 assist all Veterans on the Tohono O'odham Nation"; and

4 WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch Annex has been designated as the site of the newly  
5 established Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office  
6 ("TONVAO"); and

7 WHEREAS, the approved budget, in the amount of \$117,928.29, for the establishment  
8 of the TONVAO did not include a Renovation line item to cover  
9 anticipated renovation costs to the Legislative Branch Annex; and

10 WHEREAS, renovation costs have not been determined.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby amend  
12 Resolution No. 99-213 to include a new line item, Renovations (\$0.00) for  
13 anticipated renovation costs to the newly established Tohono O'odham  
14 Nation Veteran's Affairs Office, formerly the Legislative Branch Annex.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day  
16 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,421.0 FOR;  
17 436.5 AGAINST; 69.5 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested  
18 in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
19 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
20 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
21 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
