

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Supplemental Funds in the Amount of \$500,000.00
for the Sif Oidak District)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-215

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved an appropriation of
2 supplemental funds for each of the eleven (11) districts of the Tohono
3 O'odham Nation in the amount of \$500,000.00 per district; and

4 WHEREAS, the basis for requesting the funding was direct services and housing needs
5 for all members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
7 approves the supplemental funding in the amount of \$500,000.00 for the Sif
8 Oidak District in the form attached hereto.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes
10 the expenditure of supplemental funds until the end of December 31, 1999.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
12 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0
13 AGAINST; -0 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
14 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
15 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
16 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
17 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
