

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Submission of the FY 1999 ICDBG Grant Application)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-218**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through its Planning Department did advise**  
2 **the Communities and Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation of the**  
3 **availability of funds and types of eligible projects for the Department of**  
4 **Housing and Urban Development's Indian Community Development**  
5 **Block Grant Program (ICDBG); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the following communities and Districts did request and can be served**  
7 **within the grant ceiling limits of the ICDBG for FY 1999: Santa Rosa**  
8 **community, Gu Achi District; Vaya Chin community, Hickiwan District;**  
9 **and Pisinemo community, Pisinemo District; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development will not rate and**  
11 **rank an application if the request for funds exceeds the grant ceiling**  
12 **limit; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Executive and the Commerce and Budget and Finance Committees of**  
14 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council have reviewed the projects**  
15 **requested by the Districts; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the following projects are recommended for submission to the**  
17 **Department of Housing and Urban Development ICDBG Grant Program**  
18 **for the FY 1999 cycle:**

- 19 1. Santa Rosa, Gu Achi Community Facilities/Buildings
- 20 2. Vaya Chin, Hickiwan Community Facilities/Buildings
- 21 3. Pisinemo, Pisinemo Community Facilities/Buildings

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

- 23 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the  
24 following projects for submission to the Department of Housing and

4                                   2. Upon receipt of any and all funds acquired pursuant to this  
5                                   application, the Executive shall administer these projects through the  
6                                   Planning Department on behalf of the Education Department.

7   The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day  
8   of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR;  
9   -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in  
10  the Council by Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted  
11  by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
12  Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
13  Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




