

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Citizen Participation Certification for ICDBG FY 99)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-221

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is submitting an application to fund three**
2 **Early Childhood centers at Santa Rosa, Vaya Chin and Pisinemo**
3 **communities through the Indian Community Block Grant Program and**
4 **in connection with the approved grant, resolves and makes certain**
5 **assurances; and**

6 **WHEREAS, prior to the submission of this request, the Tohono O'odham Nation has**
7 **provided tribal citizens, especially those living in these areas where**
8 **activities are proposed, with adequate information concerning the amount**
9 **of funds available for proposed community development and housing**
10 **activities that may be assisted, and other important program**
11 **requirements, and solicited their views and participation at District**
12 **meetings prior to and at the time District resolutions were passed; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement were followed**
14 **through District Council meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative**
15 **Council meetings; and**

16 **WHEREAS, comments or views expressed by Tribal members were considered and**
17 **modified the application accordingly.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
19 **hereby certifies that the Tohono O'odham Nation provided its citizens**
20 **with the opportunity to participate in the development of the proposed**
21 **Community Development Block Grant request.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no part of this paragraph shall be construed to restrict**
23 **the responsibility and authority of the applicant for development of the**

1 application and the execution of its Community Development Block
2 Grant program. Accordingly, the citizen participation requirements of
3 this paragraph do not include concurrence by any person or group
4 involved in citizen participation in making the final determinations
5 concerning the findings and content of this proposal. The sole
6 responsibility and authority to make such final determinations rests
7 exclusively with the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
9 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,738.0 FOR;
10 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
11 vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
12 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
13 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
14 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


