

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 2000 Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program**  
**Grant Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-224**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services was  
2 approved for a grant to establish the Community Based Diabetes  
3 Prevention Program under the Special Diabetes Program for Indians,  
4 authorized by the Balanced Budget Act of 1997; and

5 WHEREAS, funds were set aside from the Special Diabetes Program for the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council through Resolution No. 98-149  
8 established and approved the Year One FY 1998 budget in the amount of  
9 \$536,566.00 for the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program and  
10 due to delay in program implementation and funding distribution, the FY  
11 1998 budget was extended to May 31, 1999.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
13 hereby approves the Year Two FY 1999 Community Based Diabetes  
14 Prevention budget in the amount of \$536,566.00 to be extended into the FY  
15 2000 for program period starting June 01, 1999 to May 31, 2000 and that any  
16 remaining funds will be carried over into the new budget.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: the  
18 Chairman and Vice-Chairman or designated official are hereby authorized  
19 to negotiate and execute the contract and expend funds when received.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day  
21 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,738.0 FOR; -0-  
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in  
23 the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
24 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by  
25 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
