

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-231

1 **WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy Assistance funds have been made available to**
2 **the Tohono O'odham Nation for FY 2000 through the State of Arizona,**
3 **Department of Commerce; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does meet the eligibility requirements to**
5 **operate a Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to apply for FY**
7 **2000 Low Income Home Energy Assistance funds to assist eligible families**
8 **with utility assistance; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to secure funding for provision**
10 **of services during fiscal year 2000; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted for**
12 **review and approval a scope of work and budget that will conform to the**
13 **eligibility criteria set for in the funding and reporting regulations.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

15 **1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorize**
16 **the officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to submit a request for**
17 **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Funding from the State of**
18 **Arizona, Department of Commerce and authorizes expenditures in**
19 **accordance to the attached budget.**

20 **2. That the duration of the grant shall be from July 01, 1999 through June**
21 **30, 2000.**

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1 3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and
2 Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to
3 negotiate and execute the contract.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
5 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,738.0 FOR; 0
6 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
7 the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
8 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
9 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
10 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
